Concept & Description

Romain Voulet : "The idea came to me following a trip to Barcelona, where I visited the Mies van der Rohe pavilion. Seeing this use of noble materials such as marble, onyx and granite was the starting point. The combination of technology with a noble rock creates an attractive tension between the eternal nature of the stone and the obsolescence of technology."

Suspended light – Polished white Carrara marble.

Round shade 80 mm H = 20 mm

Black electric cable L = 1.50 m

13 W LED module emitting 940 Lumens or the equivalent of a 75 W incandescent bulb.

Colour temperature 2700 (warm white).

Energy class : A+

Light with interchangeable LED's (in factory).

Floor lamp – Base in milled steel, stem in steel ; finished in ribbed Epoxy black lacquer (RAL 9005). Head in polished white Carrara marble.

Black electric cable. Foot-operated switch/dimmer.

16 W LED module emitting 1280 Lumens or the equivalent of a 95 W incandescent bulb.

Colour temperature 2700 (warm white).

Energy class : A+

Light with interchangeable LED's (in factory).
