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Concept & aesthetics

Alice Rosignoli was born in Turin in 1981. She studied product design at the University of Architecture in Florence. Since 2008 she has lived in Paris, where she works as a freelance designer.

She has already had the opportunity to express her motto – “improving everyday life with objects which are at once simple, timeless and poetic” – for Ligne Roset on several occasions.

Her first success : 20 wooden hangers suspended from the same number of black cords and thus was born the anarchic, iconoclastic ‘20 Hangers’!

Other creations followed, such as the practical, warm Narciso mirror and the Balançoire curved wall shelf suspended on a cord.

Cord certainly inspires Alice, for this is the very material she chose to weave to create the seat and back of the Rosalina indoor/outdoor chair.

The rose beige colour of the cord marries perfectly with the teak used for the outdoor dining tables and benches in the Ligne Roset collection.

Storage is easy since both chairs and bridges are stackable.

Quality of manufacture

Structure in quartz grey lacquered steel.
Seat and back in woven rose beige cord.
Stacking chairs. Stacking bridges.
